District Leaders		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore proven methods that foster a culture of innovation and collaboration. Develop a deeper understanding of all gears of the FRS framework. Create a vision for FRS in the district. Begin to plan next steps for your school or district.
Tech Leaders		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore strategies for procurement/selection of technologies while balancing budget/sustainability. Develop deeper understanding and knowledge about data privacy, security, and user behavior to inform district policies, practices, and protocols. Create a plan to ensure effective stakeholder communication and collaboration.
Principals		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore the skills and strategies principals need to lead a successful FRS school based upon the framework. Develop an understanding of change management and effective culture. Support participants in becoming a connected educator beyond their own school, district, and state.
Instructional Coaches		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore effective coaching strategies and the skills, tools, and resources to support a FRS school. Develop coaches as educational and instructional leaders. Connect with educators beyond the school, district, and state.
Librarians		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore how librarians can support FRS via FRL framework. Develop teacher librarians as educational and instructional leaders. Create conversations about the role of librarians supporting strategic work of schools.
